ECONOMIC SUSTAINABILITY:

- 1. **Unemployment** The goal is to reduce the number of people that don't want to be unemployed. This is something you can't always do much about as an individual. You can start a company, or you can help people get a job.
- 2. Youth unemployment: the goal is to help you find a job that fits you. You can't always get what you want, but there are things that can help. Find a good internship that you can get excited about. Try to apply for work with companies that you like. Look for opportunities at your school. Volunteer to do something that you really like doing or think is important.
- 3. **Solvability:** this something on the level of your county. It basically means that your county council has a healthy balance between their own money and the money they borrow. What can you do? Join your council or a local party and help them make priorities. Another thing you can do is make sure you get a parking ticket (parkeerboete);)
- 4. **Reduce cost of living:** The goal is to pay less in taxes. Again, this is something you can do more about on county level. But there are things you can try to achieve at home. Ask your parents to improve the isolation of your home, or get solar panels. You can also make sure that you recycle as much as you can, and that you throw away as little as you can. This will reduce the county trash taxes.
